- Transfer Station. Fee based on weight; additional fee for refrigerators and freezers.

- **Household:** Alkaline: put in the trash (cover terminals with tape) or bring to Staples. Rechargeable batteries (including lithium ion and button types) are accepted at the Transfer Station and Quilcene disposal site at their Environmental Centers for free. Rechargeable batteries also to: Home Depot, Staples, Office Depot.

Medical Equipment: ECHHO loans medical items for free. They accept walkers, wheelchairs, commode chairs, hospital beds; 2326 Washington St, PT, Mon-Fri 9-1, 360-379-3246.

Medications: *Don't flush: they damage marine life and drinking water. See also Sharps.*

- Jefferson County Sheriff's Dept, 79 Elkins Rd, PH, 360-385-3831. No sharps or vitamins.
- PT Police Dept, 1925 Blaine St, 360-385-2322. Drop box. Mon-Thu 10-3; no sharps, liquids.
- QFC and Safeway Pharmacy drop boxes, PT and Port Hadlock.

Metals: Peninsula Auto Wrecking & Recycling, 4711 S. Discovery Road. *See Appliances for fees.* 9-4:30 Mon-Thu, 9-3:30 Fri, 360-385-7603. Recycle at JeffCo Transfer Station for a fee.

Motor Oil: *Oil filters: Drain for at least 24 hours, wrap and place in your trash.*
